

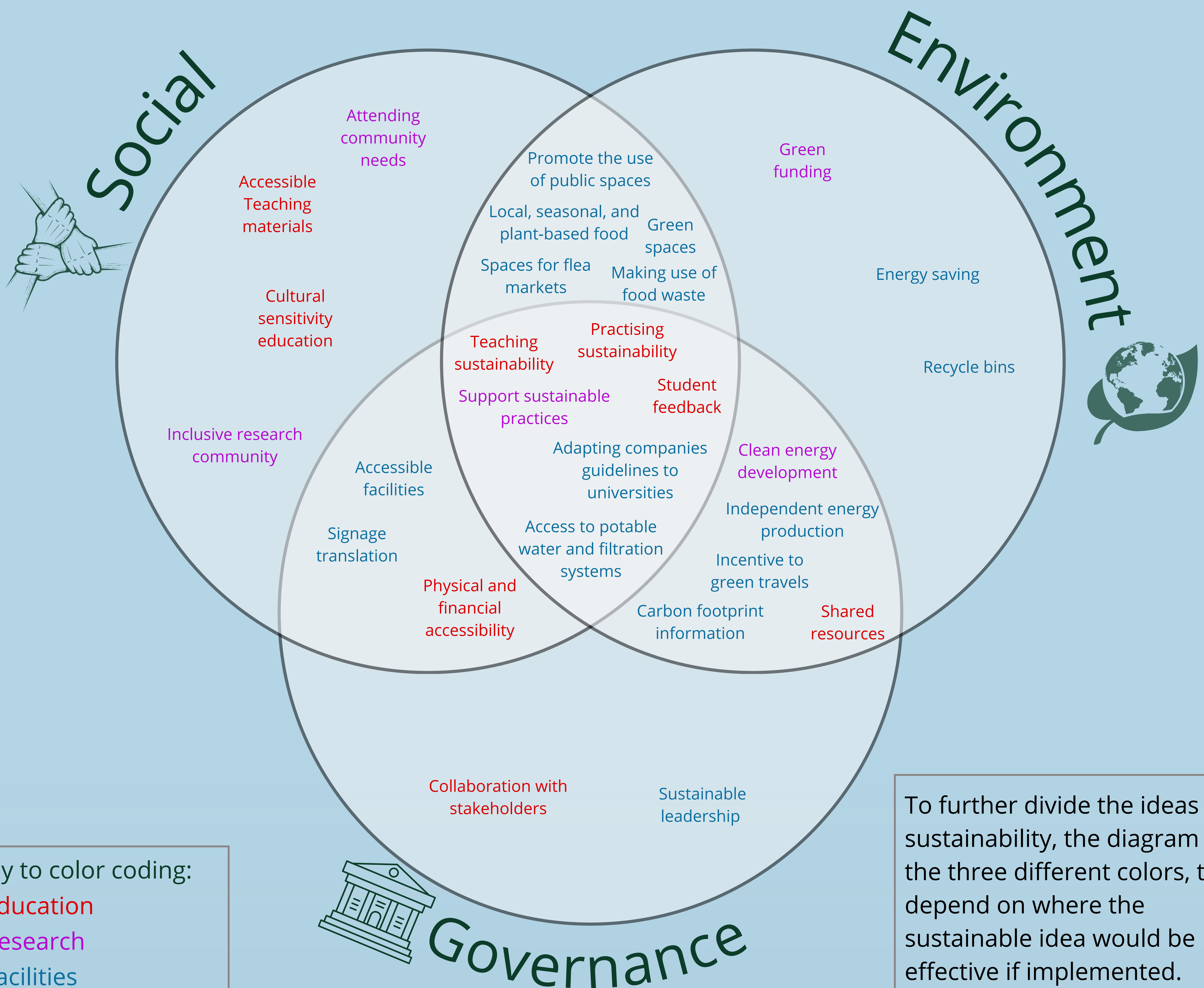
# Sustainability in Higher Education

## Introduction

The aim of this poster is to highlight different ways to increase sustainability in higher education. The topic was discussed around three interconnected aspects, namely education, research and facilities.

To understand the different dimensions of sustainability the poster focuses on the ESG framework (Environmental, Social and Governance), which covers a variety of sustainable ideas.

- **Environmental** responsibility covers the organizations' impact as well as actions on nature and the climate.
- **Social** aspects of Sustainability encompass attributes such as gender equality and diversity, universal access to shared systems of resources and fair representation.
- **Governance** refers to the structures and processes that direct and control companies.



To further divide the ideas for sustainability, the diagram has the three different colors, they depend on where the sustainable idea would be effective if implemented.

It is essential to increase awareness about sustainability, **integrating sustainable principles** into the education process.
